You need to install the VMS Lite before using VMS Lite, The installation steps are as follows:




Step 1 Double-click

The system pops up the "select install language" dialog:




Step 2 Click the drop-down list box, select the installation language and click ok. Pop-up "welcome install wizard" dialog.




Step 3 Click "Next>".

The "installation path" dialog box will pop up, as shown below:




Step 4 Click"Next>".

he system will pop up the "attach dialog box".




Step 5 Click "Next>" to install.




2 Use and operation instructions of VMS Lite

Double-click on the desktop icon VMS Lite ,to start the VMS Lite. The first time you use the VMS Lite program, you need to create a super user.



When the superadministrator user adds success, the program automatically enters the main interface. At this point, the device will be added to the interface, and the device can be added to the description of the user's use and operation instructions.



Tips:


- The first user added to the system is a super user, it has the highest authority.

2.1 Management function usage and operation instructions


Manager can use this to set the configuration and to operating other users. Therefore, this chapter mainly focuses on this part.

Depending on the permissions, users can be divided into managers and operators. Different permissions correspond to different identities.




2.1.2Add hardware

Add new devices to the managed module Device .At this time, the hardware device scan in the LAN will be automatically displayed as shown below.




2.1.2.1 Adding scanning equipment

Choose the equipment you need and click Add to




Enter the following page, If you have configured automatic validation, you can click directly

Next step .Otherwise, refer to configuring the automatic validation section for configuration, or manually enter the user and password for configuration.






2.1.2.2Configuring automatic verification


For convenience of adding devices, automatic verification can be selected. Enter the relevant interface and click on the default username password to add relevant information.



Pop up adds user name and password dialog box(Try to input all user and password combinations to add to the device).




2.1.2.3 Manual Verification hardware

Enter the IP or domain name, port number, user name, password, and the number of channels to choose the type of new equipment Driver.




2.1.2.3.2 Add hardwareSerial Numbers

Completed manually add devices, software can add up to 64 channels.




2.1.2.4edit device properties

Device properties can be operated directly on the device management interface, Select the device that needs to be operated, and click Edit .




Pop up device properties dialog box.



Here you can modify the device name, device port number, the number of devices, the device login user name and login password.


2.1.2.5 Remove equipment

Check out the device that needs to be removed and click delete. Other information associated with the change device will also be deleted automatically.




2.1.3 Storage Configuration

Click on the left to display all channels, channels of a device, or channel information of a single channel. This information is shown in the figure above.




You can also manually search for the specified device, click




2.1.3.1 Configure the storage path, stream type, retention time

Click the red arrow location to save time, video stream, and video path settings.





When the information about the channel is modified, the system will pop up the save prompt button. You can choose whether to modify the channel or cancel it.



2.1.3.2 configure the recording type, time change






2.1.3.3 Configuration Planned attribute

Click edit to enter the plan configuration screen, and click on the drop-down box to select the new option.




2.1.3.4Configuration Template

When a large number of channel configuration information needs to be modified, you can configure the template first and then apply it to the specified channel.





- 3> settings to the camera




2.1.4User Management

You can add, delete, and modify users in the "user".



2.1.4.1 Edit User Information

Click Add User ,the "add user" dialog box will pop up.



Item	Function
User type	The user's user type is divided into administrators and operators. Different user types have different permissions.
User name	Set the login name for this user.
Password	Set the user's password.
Password(repeat)	Enter the user's password again.
user access	Current user's permissions.
	Current user related camera permission information.

Configure "user type", "user name", "password", "confirm password", and relevant permission information. Single machine "save" to add user.

Introductions:


Superadministrators have the highest permissions and only one, but only when the system is first run. Super user can add administrator type user and operator type user. The administrator can only add operator user types. The permission of the user access is not greater than that of the parent user.

2.1.4.2 Edit User Information

Modify user related information. You can operate this user account and the account with lower authority than this account. Select the user line that you want to edit, and click the "Edit user" button.



You can modify the user in the dialog box that pops up. The information in the red and yellow boxes can be modified when the user has a lower access account, But the operating account is not in the yellow box for the login account.



2.1.4.3 Delete user


When you click on non-logged-in user, which is the delete user button will pop up the "confirm delete user" dialog box. Confirm that the user is deleted.

The user list will display users and users with lower permission based on the permission of the user. Users can only delete users with lower user rights than users who log in.


2.1.5 System parameter settings

The system parameters include some basic login information configuration, system language selection, storage location selection and advanced service management and import and export configuration.




2.1.5.1 Setting of basic parameters

The basic parameters are shown in the red section below.



- ① Login Options: The login options module and login interface login options are consistent. Users can set their own requirements to remember passwords and automatic login, To facilitate the landing operation or to ensure the security of the system.
- ② Language Option:Language options support the multi-lingual switch,the switch to the language will need to restart the VMS Lite software.



- ③ Storage Option:Storage options can be set to capture images, export video, and record video and other storage locations.
- Management Option: The automatic switching of the code stream automatically switches to the main code stream when the window is maximized.




2.1.5.2 SettingsAdministration options Settings

Background VMS Lite_Server program control.




The state of VMS Lite Server can be controlled. Only after the status of the video can be stored, the device state can work normally.

Step 1 Click Import Data


Step 2 Chose "Yes".

2.1.6 View Settings


The role of view is that you can pre-edit content layout and views good views, quickly switch the video area. And there will be saved to the VMS platform for later use.

There are four types of views content, 1 Camera 2 Image, 3.HTML page 4 video carousel.






2.2.1.1 Live Preview Features

- 3> View: Select the type of layout view window.
- 4> Snapshot: snapshot picture of the current window.
- 5> Close the current camera video.
- 6> PTZ control (only enabled devices that support PTZ control is effective).
- 7> Full Screen: Full-screen view






2.2.1.6 View polling

2.2.2Playback

Playback is divided into platform video playback and video playback devices.

Under VMS platform playback only in case of server configuration can have playback device playback only in the case of video equipment to playback.

- a. routine: The image is displayed in the actual proportion
- b. Stretch: The image is displayed in the window size
- c. 1 times: the image is not scaled

- d. 2 times: 2 times image to enlarge
- e. 3 times: 3 times image to enlarge
- 2> Snapshot: Save the currently selected video playback window
- 3> Export
 - a. playback platform to export the currently selected playback video window, select the time period
 - b. equipment playback in the export file selected in the list of video files
- 4> Device: Enter the playback interface device

5>Full screen: view into full screen mode


2.2.2.1 switch views video playback


- 1> in the timeline shows the currently selected window video timeline.

Synchronous playback function Toolbar description:




1> Playback area: You can select the playback range, in this range loop playback.

- 11> The timeline display range.


2.2.2.4.2 independent playback

You can specify a time range for continuous loop video playback.




2.2.2.3 Export Video Platform


You can export the video server in the client on demand. You can export the view in the window of a video recording, video can also be exported in view of all of the video window.






2.2.2.4.2 Video Search

Click the play button to start video playback of the currently selected window.




Function Playback Toolbar description:

 - 6> Adjust Timeline Display: 16-window view, click scrollable window display other time




2.2.3 Electronic Map


Map editing interface function introduction:

2.2.3.1.1 Edit Electronic map



After adding the success, the remaining operations are equivalent to adding gis maps, followed by a gis map as an example.


2.2.3.1.2 Add camera elements




The double - click element displays the real-time monitoring image of the associated monitoring point.




See video of the export list information.
